

# NHS Disclosure Statement

Congratulations you have been selected to be a member of Copper Hills High School's National Honor Society. You were chosen because of your high scholastic achievement, your commitment to service, your participation in leadership positions, and your outstanding character.

Once you turn in your required disclosure and club fee you will be inducted into the program through the formal ceremony. This is where you will recite the pledge:

**I pledge myself to uphold  
The high purposes of the National Honor Society  
to which I have been selected;  
I will be true to the principles for which it stands; I will be loyal to my school;  
And will maintain and encourage  
High standards of scholarship, service, leadership, and character.**

Once you are an official member of National Honor Society, it is expected that you will be exceedingly committed to fulfilling the promises of that pledge. In order to continue being recognized as a member of the National Honor Society, you must comply with the following:

1. **PAY \$25.00 club fee in the main office.** This must be paid in the main office by Friday, Sept. 8th. The funds which are collected through the membership fee are used to finance club activities and refreshments. If you are unable to pay by the due date, talk to Mrs. Leggat in the Media Center.

2. **Attend One National Honor Society meeting per quarter.**

Members should expect that there will be a meeting **every month** from September through May. Specific dates and times will be posted on our website <https://copperhillsnhs.wordpress.com/> and announced on our twitter (@copperhillsNHS) and Facebook pages (Copper Hills NHS). Roll will be taken at each event. Members of the NHS are encouraged to attend *all* chapter meetings but are required to attend at least one meeting per quarter. NHS students who fail to attend at least one meeting a quarter will be placed on probation.

\*It is the member's responsibility to listen to school announcements, watch for posters, and check other social media sites for information about activities and service projects. If you have any questions about NHS events, talk to Mrs. Leggat in the Media Center (NHS Advisor) or any of the club officers.

3. **Maintain a minimum 3.7 cumulative grade point average** as verified by the registrar.

4. **Participate in at least ten (10) service hours each quarter. The requirement is five (5) individual service hours and at least five (5) group service hours per quarter, equaling 10 hours total**, which are sponsored by the National Honor Society. These hours will be due in Mrs. Leggat's room by the end of each quarter. There are service hour sheets available on the website (<https://copperhillsnhs.wordpress.com/>) for your use in recording this information. The National Honor Society will be offering various opportunities throughout the school year for members to complete their hours of service. **It is very important that you keep up on your service hours. 5 of those required 10 hours MUST be completed doing NHS service projects.**

5. **Maintain a high level of character** as verified by your teachers.

If a student does not comply with all of the above stipulations, he/she will be placed on membership probation for one quarter. After that quarter, his/her membership will be re-evaluated and he/she will either be placed back on the membership list or informed of membership termination. Once a student has been terminated, he/she will be unable to re-apply for NHS membership.

## *SENIORS*

Seniors who are members of the National Honor Society and hope to wear the NHS sash at graduation **MUST** not be on probation at any time during their Senior year. Specifically, seniors must show that they have:

1. Completed all service hours (5 individual & 5 group = 10 per quarter) and have submitted those hours to Mrs. Leggat at the end of every quarter.
2. Maintained a minimum 3.7 GPA by providing a transcript from the registrar's office.
3. Attended 80% of NHS activities as verified by the rolls taken at each activity.
4. Paid the \$25.00 club fee

Membership in the National Honor Society is a privilege and an honor, but it is also a large responsibility. We look forward to making this organization an exciting and rewarding place for members to serve and lead.
